**MINUTES OF THE SECOND NAYD EXCO MEETING ON THE
8TH OF AUGUST 2010**

The meeting started at about 2:10 pm on Sunday the 8th of August 2010. There were four members in attendance from the start to the end of the meeting as opposed to the seven that were expected to attend. Those who were present were

Ndi Eugene the country coordinator, Ngegne Emmaunuel the Secretary General, Jude Thaddeus Njikem the Public relation officer, and Ntiokam Divine, the assistant Secretary General of NAYD Cameroon. The Country Coordinator called Jato Blessing and announced that she was unavoidably absent and promised to personally tell her what would be arrived at during the meeting while Ntiokam divine said the problem with Mr Bekara Fritz is that he has connection problems and cannot be part of the meeting.

This was followed by a proposed agenda by the country coordinator who doubled as the chairman of the meeting. The agenda was adopted and endorsed by the members. The agenda had four main points that is reactions to the document on the duties of bureau members of NAYD Cameroon, an update on the upcoming conference, registration of members and the coming of the country coordinator of the RDC to Cameroon from the 7-9 of September 2010.

*concerning the document on the duties of the bureau, it was clear that all have seen and are implementing. Hence not much was said about it

*On the updates concerning the nayd conference, the cc said it has been slated for the 3-5 of November 2010 and discussions will be focused on youths and conflicts management. Though members were of the opinion that discussions should be focused on health, children's rights, youth development and participation, environment, and education among others. Members proposed that the theme should be changed but the cc said the proposed project has been written and submitted to potential sponsors and cannot be changed. Members wanted to be versed with the registration formalities for participants, logistics, fees, materials, budget, sponsors etc but the cc said he is going to first meet with the CEO and get back to

members. The ASG asked for a copy of the project to carry overseas for advertisement and lobbying but the cc said until he meets with the ceo before he can respond to him. It was finally resolved that when the cc would be through with the ceo the following day, he will inform the rest of the members on the conference details and clarify some doubts concerning the conference.

*the next issue on the agenda was the registration of members as agreed during the first bureau meeting that members pay a registration of 5000FCFA and dues of 1000FCFA. Members were unanimous that the registration should be done after the conference for members would be very sceptical to register if we don't explain the use of the funds. this explanation would be done during the conference. The cc also said he will book for a meeting of the bureau members and the ceo where much would be discussed.

*the issue on the election of regional representatives came up and the cc said it will done as soon as the bureau has some funds for it will be through a transparent election and added that he is working out with the webmaster to group all the members into various regions so as to facilitate the task of the election. It was resolved that if at the end of the mandate of the bureau the election is not accomplished it will be left to the next bureau to implement.

*On the visit of the CC of the Democratic Republic of the Congo to Cameroon, the cc said the bureau is going to receive him though he is coming for his private meeting to Cameroon. He said for the fact that the cc of the DRC has contacted him to announce his coming has proposed to meet with us we will do but said he is going to discuss it with the ceo and inform members on the developments.

In his closing remarks the cc regretted the absence of the assistant cc saying he personally called him last week but he has not made it to the meeting. But said it has not called for any debate.

The meeting ended at about 3:47pm.
