\* we also decided to advertise the networks activities and invite new members to join us.

On our plan of action, we arrived at the following resolutions:

\* There was a suggestion from the CC plan of action which talked about a conference of NAYD Cameroon. The country coordinator asked us to be patient and that he has to discuss with the CEO first but said we should

keep our fingers crossed for the conference comes up soonest.

\* We also suggested that Regional Coordinator for NAYD be appointed so that they follow the activities in their regions.

\* Divine gave a suggestion that books, pen and bags be printed for the conference that will be organised.

\* The meeting day for the exco was programmed for the second Sunday of each month.

For the other issues, it was programmed for a later date for discussion.

The meeting ended at about 4:20pm.
